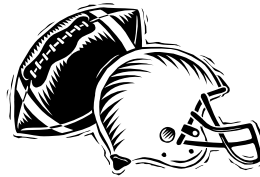

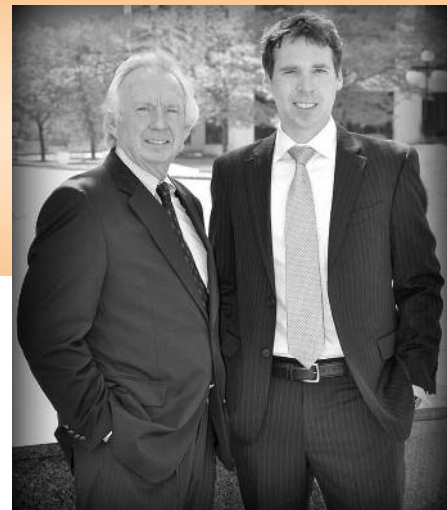

ISC Steak Fry with special guest Pat Ryan, Metamora H.S. Football Coach ... successful and very rewarding evening

The Lariat Steak House was again the site of the ISC's Annual Steak Fry on Thursday, November 21st, and as always, the food was great. Never any doubt about that...plus the event was a great night out for past presidents, friends and guests of ISC members. Over 60 people attended, including 11 past presidents, with everyone having a great time!!! Jeff Doeden won \$100 in the 50/50 drawing and graciously donated it to be added to our \$500 grant given to the Washington High School Athletic Department. Thanks, Jeff!!!

With all in attendance filled with food and refreshments, Pat Ryan stepped to the podium to enlighten us about his 24-year stint as the Metamora High School Head Football Coach with an overall record of 228-55. Under Pat's tutelage, his teams made the IHSA playoffs 20 times, making the championship game 7



times with two state championships and five 2nd place finishes.

Pat began by explaining how important sports medicine was to

high school sports. Area doctors initiated a program that promoted year-round weight training. This keeps the athletes in contact with the coaching staff and more importantly maintains a

healthy body. The current trend regarding concussions has posed concern among all involved in the sport. The potential long-term effect to the player requires special attention to these injuries as they occur.

He explained how important it is to recognize the efforts of all players on the team and not just those who are always in the limelight. Teach players to be good losers and not point the finger at fellow teammates when something goes wrong. It is very important to identify players who can be team leaders. These are

usually seniors but he has seen some underclassmen who have this ability. These individuals set the example for the other players on the team. When the game is tight in the 4th quarter, these are the guys you can count on to inspire and ignite the team. Kids do not want to hear that the best is behind us.

Pat is now starting to coach second generation kids and he can see the similarity in work ethic and attitude. He hopes that he teaches those he has coached to overcome adversities as they may arise in life's travels as well as those that occurred on the football field. He had the special privilege of coaching his son Sam for 3 years. With several area high school football officials in attendance, Pat was able to reminisce about some sideline and game situations that have occurred over the years.

ISC Scholarships 2014... 2 boys /2 girls will receive \$1,000 scholarships

In 1997, the ISC decided to begin a scholarship program for graduating senior student athletes who planned to continue their education at a four year college or university. To date, the ISC has granted over \$50,000 since the inception of our scholarship program.

Since 2005, we have awarded 4 - \$1,000 scholarships each year to 2 boys and 2 girls. Beginning in mid-March, an ISC Board member committee consisting of Rich Moore, Billy King, Ron King, Bill Molleck and Matt Meyer will solicit nominations from about two dozen area high schools. An e-mail will be sent to each school's Principal, Athletic Director and Counseling Department with cover letter explaining the program and timeline along with the application form. Applicants are judged on the merit of their scholastic performance, along with activity in school sports, plus community service, financial need, and the effort put in to prepare the application.

The application process usually ends around the third week of April with the committee presenting their selection of the four successful applicants to the Board for approval at the May 5 meeting. The \$1,000 checks are given to the winners at the June Board meeting.

E-MAIL NEWSLETTER

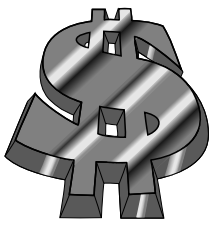

YOUTH SPORTS FINANCIAL AID REPORT:

ISC is organized to help provide Central Illinois youth the best sports programs in the country. To fulfill this pledge, we provide annual financial aid grants to various youth sports organizations throughout Central Illinois. These grants are used to offset expenses incurred to run the programs. Each organization fills out our application form and the ISC Board of Directors decides if the request is granted. At our Annual Meeting, the membership approved a financial aid grant budget of \$14,000.00 for fiscal year April 1, 2013 – March 31, 2014 with \$9,450.00 awarded as of this newsletter. Since 1996, ISC has provided over \$260,000.00 in financial aid grants to youth sports groups. We are able to do this with the support of our membership.

Since the May 2013 newsletter, the ISC board has approved financial aid grants totaling \$7,450.00 to the 16 youth sports organizations listed below for the 2012/2013 fiscal year. A special note – the ISC Board voted to give the Washington High School Athletic Department \$500 to be used to offset the cost to replace athletic apparel and equipment lost by student athletes as a result of the devastating tornado that struck their community.

Providing these annual financial aid grants to Central Illinois youth sports organizations is the backbone of the Independent Sports Club of Central Illinois. This is only made possible by the participation of our membership and friends in the various fund raisers held throughout the year.
