ISC March Madness 2016 \$100 Squares Board

The ISC is selling a \$100 squares board for the 2016 NCAA Men's Basketball Tournament. This board pays 67 winners! The Championship Game winning square takes home \$1,500.00!! This is a typical 100 square board with each square costing \$100.00. Payment (cash or check) must be received by an ISC board member (list on page 5 of this newsletter) and confirmed to the commissioner (Jeff Doeden) within three days of reserving a square through this site. All squares must be paid for prior to the start of the first game of the tournament.

Each square is good for every game in the NCAA tournament. There is no limit to the # of times a square can win. Numbers (0-

9) will be assigned to the grid once all squares are purchased. Away team numbers are listed on the left side of the board and the Home team numbers listed across the top of the board. The HOME team is listed on the bottom of a box score, and ESPN.com is the source for discrepancies. **Example:** If a round 4 game ends with Away Team 74, Home Team 85, then Away 4 Home 5 square wins \$320.

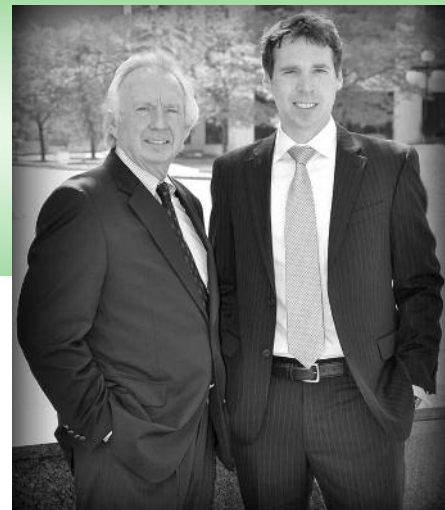

YOUTH SPORTS FINANCIAL AID REPORT

ISC is organized to help provide Central Illinois youth the best sports programs in the country. To fulfill this pledge, we provide annual financial aid grants to various youth sports organizations throughout Central Illinois. These grants are used to offset expenses incurred to run the programs. Each organization fills out our application form and the ISC Board of Directors decides if the request is granted. At our

Annual Meeting on March 26, 2015, the membership approved a financial aid grant budget of \$16,000 for fiscal year April 1, 2015 – March 31, 2016 with \$13,550 awarded as of this newsletter. Since 1996, ISC has provided over \$270,000 in financial aid grants to youth sports groups. We are able to do this with the support of our membership.

Since the November 2015 newsletter, the ISC board has approved financial aid grants totaling \$3,600 to the 6 youth sports organizations listed below for the 2015/2016 fiscal year.

Illinois vs. Nebraska basketball bus trip ... Saturday January 16, 2016

Over the years the ISC has entertained numerous bus trip fundraising ventures to various college and professional sports venues. Some were very successful and some, in later years, were not mainly due to the increasing cost of the bus and tickets, so we decided to end the trips. If memory serves correct, and that is questionable, there were many good times had by all on the bus trips to Wrigleyville to watch the Cubs vs. Cards games. Remember the 5 hour ride to Milwaukee!! It's a good thing the 16 oz. cans were the same price as the 12 oz. as we needed the extra volume.

Following the Smoker in October of 2010, ISC member Jeff Shaw (Pres. 2004) decided to resurrect a fundraising bus trip to a University of Illinois basketball game at Assembly Hall in Champaign. He found that tickets were available during Christmas break, so he secured 40, arranged for a bus and put out the word about the trip.

We sold 38 of the 40 tickets, had a box lunch to eat, and loaded 2 coolers with beer and soda. The Illini were playing Northwestern and little did we know that

Illinois would destroy the Wildcats 88-63 while setting a record for rebounding. It was a great trip with an Illini win, ISC clearing over \$600, and the comradery that evolved on the bus.

The next year, Rich Moore and Geoff Smith stepped up to the plate and secured 50 tickets for Ohio State vs. Illinois. With the Buckeyes ranked #2 and the Illini #24, it didn't take long for the bus to sell out. At game time, OSU had dropped to #5 and U of I to #28, but it turned out to be one helluva game. Illinois was down 39-34 at half, but came back to win the game 79-74 with some great basketball being played in the last minute of the game. We also cleared over \$1,200.

Then things started to change as it became harder to sell these bus trips to our membership. This did not in any way diminish or sway the effort put out by Rich and Geoff in organizing these trips.

On Saturday, January 16, 2016, a band of intrepid Illini fans rode in a partially filled charter coach to watch the 2015-2016 Fighting Illini basketball team host the Huskers of Nebraska at the newly remodeled State Farm Center,

"Assembly Hall." You know, we're never going to be comfortable with the "naming" of the sacred Hall. Hell, we lost the Chief. We're struggling in football and frankly we're taking pipe on the basketball court every couple of days.

Enough of that. We settled into our seats and saw the Illini lose a game that they totally could have won. Our members are always stoked up after the Smoker and feel that maybe, just maybe, the team will put together a strong season and make its way back into the NCAA tournament in March. We will once again have to put those dreams aside for another spring.

We are still hoping to put together another trip next January. We always have a great time going to and from the game. We enjoy unlimited beverages. Beer, soda, water, a half Gondola sandwich from Avanti's and a bag of chips. Tip boards provide a game of chance, a shot at some quick cash and a distraction from the reality of a bus ride. We've got to remain faithful to the orange and blue and the storied history of Illini basketball. Anyway stay tuned for another trip next year.
