Minutes Report – Motion by Bill King to approve the May minutes, second by Derek Pitzer. Motion passed.

Treasurer’s Reports – Motion by Bobby Joseph to approve the May treasurer’s report, second by Jeff Doeden. Motion passed.

Financial Grant Requests –

Peoria Baseball Association – Ryan Kenny. Baseball. Ages 6-16. 100 boys. 100 girls. \$0 registration fee. \$700 requested. Funds requested include: ‘Running free youth baseball clinics Monday-Thursday at Carver Center and Von Stueben middle school through June and July. Fees are needed for equipment (gloves, cleats, bats)’. Last grant awarded: First request. Motion by Bobby Joseph to award \$700, second by Andy Weeks. Motion passed.

Dunlap JFL – Brent Allen. Football & cheerleading. Ages 5-14. 175 boys. 75 girls. \$165 registration fee. \$700 requested. Funds requested include: ‘We are purchasing new football uniforms for all tackle levels (~\$9000), reconditioning many helmets and buying several new football pads. We also need the money for everyday

expenses: such as field maintenance, field markings, pay the JFL OCI for insurance and referees and umpires.'. Last grant awarded: May 2020 (\$700). Motion by Jeff Doeden to award \$700, second by David Hunt. Motion passed.

Washington Park District – Matt Suellentrop. Basketball. Ages K-8. 300 boys. 125 girls. \$95 registration fee. \$700 requested. Funds requested include: 'We have Little Hoopers for Kindergarten and 1st grade that is \$50 that was included in the above numbers as well as boys and girls 2-3rd grade, 4-5th grade and 6-8th grade that is included in the overall numbers. We participate in cooperation with other communities to allow for a better overall league experience. Funds pay for balls, shirts, awards, gym rental for a small percentage of teams, and officials'. Last grant awarded: March 2018 (\$600). Motion by Jeff Doeden to award \$700, second by Andy Weeks. Motion passed.

Washington Park District – Matt Suellentrop. Youth soccer. Ages 4-12. 312 boys. 150 girls. \$50 registration fee. \$700 requested. Funds requested include: 'Youth Soccer player fees go towards the use of shirts and awards as well as equipment including balls, bags, soccer nets, soccer goals, lining and maintenance of fields. We also utilize soccer officials for certain age groups offering both a spring and fall season.'. Last grant awarded: July 2019 (\$700). Motion by Jeff Doeden to award \$700, second by Andy Weeks. Motion passed.

Shade Memorial Youth Camp – Bryan Cheek. Baseball/softball. Ages 4-17. 400 boys. 300 girls. \$90 registration fee. Funds requested include: 'We would like to use these funds for additional equipment purchases. Baseballs, softballs, protective gear, etc.'. Last grant awarded: November 2020 (\$700). Motion by David Hunt to award \$700, second by Andy Weeks. Motion passed.

Brimfield High School Trap Club – Adam Zimmerman. Trap Shooting. Ages 11-18. 30 boys. 10 girls. \$190 registration fee. Funds requested include: 'Offset the sky rocketing cost of ammunition, 60% increase in 2021; Offset cost of State trap meet, unlike other schools we allow the entire to attend if they so choose too; Offset the cost of taking our top qualified shooters, 10 max.(boys and/or girls) to US National High School (grade school if applicable) Trap meet in Mason Michigan July 2021'. Last grant awarded: February 2019 (\$500). Motion by Andy Weeks to award \$700, second by Bill Molleck. Motion passed.

Old Business –

Golf Outing – Chris Peterson was absent, but Adam Duvall reported he would be updating the website and flyer for the outing scheduled for Friday, August 13.

Chiefs Game – Pat Lavery reported that Chiefs GM Jason Mott said the ISC could receive a full refund from its 2020 ticket purchase or get tickets for this season. The board discussed getting a refund and trying again in 2022.
