Financial Grant Requests –

Elmwood Summer Youth League – Brett Stevens. Baseball/softball/t-ball. Ages 4-15. 100 boys. 83 girls. \$50 registration fee. \$500 requested. Funds requested include: ‘With costs rising on everything, we really don't want to strap our parents anymore than possible. We have remained at \$50 when all other towns have risen. So we would use this to get newer gear\equipment as it ages, get better field prep equipment to prepare the diamonds. Any help would be greatly appreciated.’ Last grant awarded: First request. Motion by Bobby Joseph to award \$700, second by Andy Weeks. Motion passed.

Peoria Area Water Wizards – Scott Mousty. Swimming. Ages 6-19. 40 boys. 63 girls. \$75 registration fee. \$700 requested. Funds requested include: ‘Provide funding in support of our Annual Summer Swimming Championship meet (PAWW Summer Sizzler). This swim meet is conducted each summer and is an opportunity for the Community, Park District and Country Club swim programs from across Central Illinois to compete in

events showcasing all the strokes and across several age groups. This year will make the 77th annual occurrence of this swim meet (formerly known as the Journal Star meet). The event normally draws 200-300 swimmers each year. Last grant awarded: May 2019 (\$700). Motion by Bill Molleck to award \$700, second by David Hunt. Motion passed.
