Minutes Report – Motion by David Hunt to approve the November minutes, second by Derek Pitzer. Motion passed.

Treasurer’s Report – Motion by Derek Pitzer to approve the November treasurer’s report, second by Kevin Day. Motion passed.

Financial Grant Requests –

Blue Crew Wrestling Club – Tom and Lisa Inman. Wrestling. Ages 3-14. 57 boys. 16 girls. \$1 registration fee. \$700 requested. Funds requested include: *“This money would exclusively be used for entry fees for our athletes. Cost per athlete per season is around \$450. As we are one of the states only FREE wrestling clubs, we serve many under privileged athletes. The club covers the costs associated with, entry fees, singlets, a club t-shirt and wrestling shoes (shoes are first come first serve based on size). Head gear is the only cost incurred by the athlete. The pandemic has really put a huge financial burden on our nearly 40 year old club. We are looking at a total operating expense this season of nearly \$32,850. We currently hold \$7,800 in our club account. Thank you for your time and consideration.”* Last grant awarded: First request. Motion by Andy Weeks to approve \$700, second by David Hunt. Motion passed.

The Christian Center – Chad Bailey. Basketball. Ages 6-18. 372 boys. 192 girls. \$80 registration fee. \$700 requested. Funds requested include: *“This year, nearly 600 area boys and girls, age 6 to 18 will play Christian Center basketball. We teach kids the right way to play sports--play hard, play safe and play fair--emphasizing the fundamentals. We will use this grant to help cover the costs of presenting our basketball program to the community; equipment, referee costs, facility rental, and more. Though our player registration fee is \$80, our services are offered regardless of ability to pay. Each year, we scholarship more than 50 low-income families so that they can play Christian Center sports.”* Last grant awarded: \$700 (Sept. 2021). Motion by Jeff Doeden to approve \$700, second by David Hunt. Motion passed.
