Financial Grant Requests –

Curley “Boo” Johnson’s Skills for Life Basketball Academy Camps – Curley “Boo” Johnson. Basketball. Ages 8-18. 350 boys. 475 girls. \$190 registration fee. \$700 requested. Funds requested include: ‘To provide scholarships for 10 kids in need. I will match the contribution...’. Last grant awarded: April 2021 (\$700). Motion to approve \$700 by Jeff Doeden, second by Bill Molleck.

Brimfield Youth Baseball Association – Michael Meinders. Baseball, softball, tee-ball. Ages 4-15. 65 boys. 48 girls. \$60 registration fee. \$500 requested. Funds requested include: ‘We would use the funds to help off set the scholarships given to players that weren’t able to pay. We try to supply those kids whatever they might need for

the season within reason. For example: fees, glove, cleats, pants, and face mask are some of the extras we try to help with. We are currently have 9 kids on full scholarship and multiple others on partial or equipment scholarships. We are trying to keep our fees low and still get the less fortunate kids playing. Thank you for any support.' Last grant awarded: April 2019 (\$700). Motion to approve \$700 by Jeff Doeden, second by Andy Weeks.

Richwoods Youth Baseball – Corey Kelly/Dan Adler. Baseball. Ages 7-18. 325 boys. 0 girls. \$325 registration fee. \$700 requested. Funds requested include: 'equipment, uniforms, field maintenance, umpire, tourney fees.' Last grant awarded: April 2021 (\$700). Motion to deny by David Hunt, second by Andy Weeks.

Dunlap Rec. Association – Tony Rapplean. Baseball and softball. Ages 5-15. 350 boys. 125 girls. \$75 registration fee. \$700 requested. Funds requested include: 'New equipment (catchers gear and new baseballs/softballs) and umpire fees.' Last grant awarded: Nov. 2017 (\$500). Motion to approve \$700 by David Hunt, second by Kevin Joseph.

Peoria Youth Baseball League – Ryan Kenny. Baseball. Ages 9-14. 200 boys. 0 girls. \$0 registration fee. \$700 requested. Funds requested include: 'We are a 501c organization established in 2021. We offered free clinics last summer and now we are entering inaugural season of the new Peoria Youth Baseball League. This developmental league is free to 9-14 year olds, runs 8 weeks (June-July) and will take place at Peoria stadium every Monday-Thursday evening.' Last grant awarded: June 2021 (\$700). Motion to approve \$700 by Bill Molleck, second by Kevin Day.

309 Punishers – Demarko Haris. Football. Ages 6-14. 60 boys. 0 girls. \$200 registration fee. \$700 requested. Funds requested include: 'The money is intended to be used for equipment, uniforms, travel fee,s van rentals, gas, and food for kid etc...'. Last grant awarded: First request.
